CMS have launched a nationwide campaign designed to get people thinking about mission. Part of this is the UK's first ever mission themed card game.

This is a fun and interactive way to stimulate people's thinking about mission and broaden their perspective of the reality of mission in the 21st century. *"Our central belief is that all of God's people are called to join in God's mission yet we suspect many people's narrow definition of what 'mission' really means, is a major contributor to their hesitation about getting involved. This game is a fun way to challenge those misconceptions and broaden people's understanding of how they can be a part of God's mission."*

CMS plan to help people to engage further with a mission based bible study, which will be available later in the year. We have four of these card games - see the Wardens - if you would like to try one out - *the game is really quite good!*
